Senators Gatchalian, Villanueva stress urgency of passing TEC reform bill in sponsorship speeches



Sen. Sherwin Gatchalian—chair of the Senate Committee on Basic Education, Arts, and Culture, and Sen. Joel Villanueva—chair of the Senate Committee on Higher, and Technical and Vocational Education—underscored the urgency of passing the proposed Senate Bill No. 2152 or the Teacher Education Excellence Act as they delivered their sponsorship speeches respectively during the Senate's plenary session on 17 May 2021.

Sen. Gatchalian said the bill will "address the failure of the country's teacher education system to produce the highest caliber of educators." **Read more about Sen. Gatchalian's speech**
