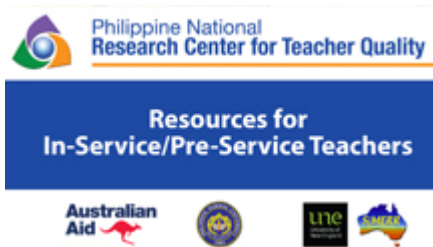
Work with DepEd continues while on ECQ
